AUDITIONS

All audition materials are downloadable from the BMT website - please register there too, selecting up to two parts you would like to audition for - if you are unsuccessful in those parts, but we feel like you may suit another, we will have that discussion with you when we offer out roles.

You will be sent a timeslot for your audition the week before - however, please leave the whole day free where possible, as we may get auditionees to read together etc

We really want to see the characters being portrayed, so we would prefer you off book - there will be members of the production team reading in and prompting you where needed- we know there will be nerves and mistakes, but we want you to be able to really perform your roles!

The dance and movement audition pieces will be shared on video on our website - please familiarise yourself with it as best as you can before the audition day!

CAST COMMITMENTS

Rehearsals start February 2026. They run every Monday and Wednesday from 7.30pm until 10pm. Whilst you may not be needed for every rehearsal you should plan to be available as we may need to make changes as we go. We also plan on having several Sunday rehearsals, and will share the dates of these at the first cast read-through!

We need to know, in advance, of any holidays that you plan to take - please share them when applying to audition - it's purely for scheduling purposes and should not affect any decision making!. No holidays are permitted in the two weeks before show week.

If you are going to miss any rehearsals (including scheduled holidays / sickness / work events etc.) we would like you to try and supply a stand in (either from the cast or from our BMT Community) and catch upon what you have missed.

We do not charge membership or audition fees, but we do ask for a show fee. For this production it will be £70, which will include a production T-Shirt, and needs to be paid by the end of March 2026.

We ask that EVERYONE commits to AT LEAST 2 of the fundraising and promotional events. Dates will be available at the first rehearsal in January, so that you can plan ahead!
